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## **Keysight Technologies statement on Classification, Labeling and Packaging (EU Regulation 1272/2008/EC)**

Keysight Technologies, Inc. is aware of its obligations in the European Union under a new regulation regarding classification, labelling and packaging of substance and mixtures, referred to as CLP 1272/2008/EC, which came into force January 20, 2009 and is directly applicable to industry.

CLP is based on the United Nations Globally Harmonised System (GHS) of classification aiming to harmonize the classification and hazard communication of chemicals (label and safety data sheet, now referred to as SDS). It ensures a high level of protection of human health and the environment and lowers barriers for global trade.

There are two key implementation timelines:

- By December 1, 2010, all substances shall be classified and labelled in accordance with GHS criteria
- By June 1, 2015, all mixtures shall be classified and labelled in accordance with GHS criteria.

Keysight will ensure classification and labelling of all substances are in accordance with the GHS criteria. This includes but is not limited to:

- Classify in accordance to new classification requirements set forth in EU Regulation 1272/2008/EC
- Offer Safety Data Sheets (SDS's) which includes updated CLP classification information
- Ensure product package labelling meets all new labelling requirements
- Compliance to product packaging per EU Regulation 1272/2008/EC.
