INDEPENDENT LIMITED ASSURANCE STATEMENT

Introduction and objectives of work

Apex Companies, LLC (Apex) has been engaged by Keysight Technologies (Keysight) to provide limited assurance of its water withdrawal and water discharge data. This assurance statement applies to the Subject Matter included within the scope of work described below.

This information and the presentation of the Subject Matter are the sole responsibility of the management of Keysight. Our sole responsibility was to provide independent assurance on the accuracy of the Subject Matter.

Scope of work

The scope of our work was limited to assurance over water withdrawal and water discharge for the period Fiscal Year 2022 (November 1, 2021 to October 31, 2022) (the 'Subject Matter').

Data and information supporting water withdrawal and water discharge were in some cases estimated rather than historical.

Reporting Boundaries

The following are the boundaries used by Keysight for reporting sustainability data:

- Worldwide

Limitations and Exclusions

Excluded from the scope of our work is any verification of information relating to:

Activities outside the defined assurance period.

This limited assurance engagement relies on a risk based selected sample of sustainability data and the associated limitations that this entails. The reliability of the reported data is dependent on the accuracy of metering and other production measurement arrangements employed at site level, not addressed as part of this assurance. This independent statement should not be relied upon to detect all errors, omissions or misstatements that may exist.

Responsibilities

This preparation and presentation of the Subject Matter are the sole responsibility of the management of Keysight.

Apex was not involved in the drafting of the Reporting Criteria. Our responsibilities were to:

- obtain limited assurance about whether the Subject Matter has been prepared in accordance with the Reporting Criteria;
- form an independent conclusion based on the assurance procedures performed and evidence obtained; and
- report our conclusions to the Directors of Keysight.

Assessment Standards

 We performed our work in accordance with Apex's standard procedures and guidelines for external Assurance of Sustainability Reports and International Standard on Assurance Engagements (ISAE) 3000 Revised, Assurance Engagements Other than Audits or Reviews of Historical Financial Information (effective for assurance reports dated on or after Dec. 15, 2015), issued by the International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board. A materiality threshold of ±5percent was set for the assurance process.

Summary of Work Performed

As part of our independent assurance, our work included:

- Assessing the appropriateness of the Reporting Criteria for the Subject Matter;
- 2. Conducting interviews with relevant personnel of Keysight;
- Reviewing the data collection and consolidation processes used to compile Subject Matter, including assessing assumptions made, and the data scope and reporting boundaries;
- 4. Reviewing documentary evidence provided by Keysight;
- 5. Agreeing a selection of the Subject Matter to the corresponding source documentation; and
- 6. Reviewing Keysight systems for quantitative data aggregation and analysis.

Conclusion

On the basis of our methodology and the activities described above:

- Nothing has come to our attention to indicate that the Subject Matter is not fairly stated in all material respects; and
- It is our opinion that Keysight has established appropriate systems for the collection, aggregation and analysis of quantitative data.

A summary of the data within the scope of assurance for Fiscal Year 2022 is attached.
